Everyday our food is produced through a series of movements and transactions across a wide geographical area. At each step across the food system there are transactions of money and product, production of ingredients and raw materials into animal feed and food for the market.

Understanding this complex food system requires information on the biological and technical relationships between inputs and outputs, the prices of goods and services

and the rules and enforcement systems that people and organisations work under.
